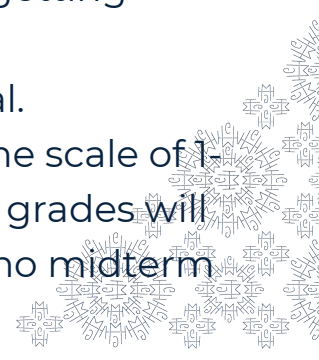


# National Emergency Situation - Exit Plan

- Although the distance learning continues until the end of the school year, we are making plans for reopening the building and inviting our teachers/employees back to work (voluntary and based on need). The recommendations from the ministry for organizing in-door learning activities starting May 15 need to be followed.
- From May 18, the school's office will be open every day between 9.00-14.00.
- The school gates (both Kooli and Tõnissoni street) are open from May 18 on workdays between 9.00-14.00.
- The library is still closed and exchanging books is organized by the librarian contact-free.
- Teachers working in the building: there is a schedule for observing the arrival and leaving of teachers and students. One teacher can invite up to 10 students to school at first. All rooms are equipped with hand sanitizers. Masks are available in the office upon need.
- Ending the school year: according to the current plan, the 9th grade graduation ceremony will take place on 19.06 at 16.00 and the 12th grade graduation ceremony will happen on 20.06 at 15.00. It is allowed to have outdoor events with up to 100 people and indoor events with 50 people at that time. We are hoping for a nice weather.

## Distance Learning and Grading

- In general, we are continuing with the distance learning until the end of the school year. Teachers are allowed to invite single students or small groups to school (based on the recommendations of the Ministry of Education)
- The school year for the basic school ends on June 8. The meeting of the teachers' board will take place on June 4.
- The teachers' board meetings for the graduation of grades 10-11 takes place on June 15 and for grades 9 and 12 on June 16.
- Learning outcomes of the primary grades (1-4) will continue getting narrative descriptions for assessment.
- Grades 5-9 continue with criterion-based assessment as usual.
- All secondary school grading (except DP) will take place on the scale of 1-5. The optional course will be assessed with pass / fail. Course grades will be formed based on formative tasks throughout the course; no midterm exams take place.

14.–16. place Oliver Mõttus from 11a (supervisor Urma Linnus),


14.–18. place Maarja Kask from 10b (juhendaja Urma Linnus).
