MEDIA TEACHER



Alustasin septembris 12. klassi meediaõpetaja ametis. Õpetaja ma hariduselt ei ole, olen hoopis ajakirjanik, aga just see aasta on huvitaval kombel toonud juba mitu väljakutset meediahariduse vallas.

Ilmselt seetõttu, et oma põhitöökohalt ERRi raadiouudiste toimetusest olen hetkel lapsepuhkusel. Lisaks MHG õpilastele töotan ka Tartu Ülikooli ajakirjandustudengitega. Väike meediatunni vedamise kogemus on mul õppeaastast 2013-2014, kui töötasin Tartu Descartes'i Lütseumis. Enne raadiouudisteni jõudmist töötasin Tartu Postimehes spordireporterina, viimastel aastatel olen kaastööd teinud ajakirjale Ma olen Jalgrattur ja Eesti Teadusagentuuri portaalile Research in Estonia.

Vabal ajal meeldib mulle tegeleda spordiga ja jälgida kultuurielu selle erinevates ilmingutes, aga seoses kahe väikese pojaaga on need hobid praegu veidi tahaplaanile jäänud ning vabad päevad mööduvad praegusel ajal pigem loodust ja maailma avastades.

In September I started my job as a media teacher. Media class is for 12th class. Being a teacher is not my basic job, actually I am a journalist, but year 2020 has brought me some new challenges on the field of media education. I guess one of the reasons can be that I am currently on maternity leave from my main job – from the radio news department of Estonian Public Broadcasting where I am reporter. In addition to MHG pupils I work with journalism students of the University of Tartu.

I have a small experience as a media teacher from the years 2013-2014 when I was working in Tartu Descartes' Lyceum. Before finding my place as a radio news reporter I worked as a sports reporter in Tartu Postimees, in recent years I have also been writing articles to magazine called Ma olen Jalgrattur which covers different aspects of cycling culture and to Estonian Research Council's portal Research in Estonia.

My favourite leisure time activities have always been connected with sport and culture but at the moment these fields are rather in the background, as the time passes by while wondering around in the nature with my two young sons, learning new things in the world with them.
