#### **WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS**

- In the Social Studies Olympiad regional round, our 5th-6th grade students stood out. Among the 2nd school level of Tartu, Mikk Mihkel Ruus (6b) won 1st place, Kaia Oder (6b) took 2nd place, Roosi Kõiv (5b) 3rd and Anni Maria Volt (6b) 4th place. Tristan Erik Teniste (5a) took 6th place, Roberta Anette Annuk (5b) in 9th place and Loviise Juus (5a) in 10th place. Kaarel Viljaste supervised the students. Among the pupils of the 3rd school level, Iris Kivi (9b) came 5th and Teele Piibemann (9b) 10th. Supervised by Kaarel Viljaste and Alla Vinitšenko.




