

- In the regional round of the Physics Olympiad, Uku Märt Raasik (9b, teacher Riina Murulaid) won 2nd place among the 9th grades, and Linda Maria Pool (9b, Riina Murulaid) shared 7th-8th place. The 11th-12th place was shared by Mart Väljamäe and Iris Kivi (both 9b, Riina Murulaid). Among the 10th grades, Andri Türkson (10b, Riina Murulaid) shared 2nd-3rd place, Erik Julius Lindgren (10b, Riina Murulaid) received 4th place, the 6th-7th place was shared by Karolin Ruumet (10a, Riina Murulaid) and 8th place went to Meena Rooden (10b, Riina Murulaid). In the 11th grade competition, the first place was won by Laur Saks (11DP, teacher Leo Siiman), the 5th place went to Triin Punab (11DP, Leo Siiman), Tönu Uustare (11DP, Leo Siiman) became 6th and Heorhii Pasternak (11DP, Leo Siiman) 7th. Among the 12th grades, Keidi Käärmann (12DP, teacher Riina Murulaid) came 4th.
- Four of our students took part in the national finals of the Religious Studies Olympiad: Sander Metsis (12a), Jekaterina Marova (12a), Margaret Roost (10c) and Taivi Lavits (10a). Jekaterina Marova shared 14th-15th place among grades 12, Margaret Roost was 6th among 10th grades and Taivi Lavits 11th. The best result was achieved by Sander Metsis, who was invited to the national round. Our students were supervised by Kätlin Liimets.
- On 8 February, Katrina Laur (9a, teacher Jana Kübar) won 2nd place in the Vello Saage poetry competition for 7th-9th graders. Laura Liisa Vider (7b, teacher Auli Auväärt) won a special prize for "The most cinematic poem".
- Mirtel Tähepõld (11b) and Triin Punab (11DP) won the Ultimate Frisbee tournament in Lithuania with their team.



HÄRMA STUDENTS AT THE STUDENT COMPANIES FAIR

On Saturday, the students of our school participated with their student companies in the Estonian Student Companies Fair in Tallinn. A total of 268 companies from all over Estonia took part in the fair over two days, and all four companies from our student company elective course were represented. Represented were:

A jury also visited the fair; their feedback to our students was inspiring, and they saw the potential. The five-hour sales day at the Rocca al Mare Centre was tiring, but it certainly gave them a lot.

FEBRUARY OF MAR On the 9th of February, alumna Linda Tuubel spoke to the 4th graders about the importance of exercise and health.



















MHG SCHOOL BALL DANCE FOR GRADES 9-12
