WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

- Leo Fišel (7b, teacher Helen Rägo) won 3rd place in the language-B section of the French Olympiad. Mari Mai Ruus (12DP, teacher Aija Sprivul-Dautancourt) won the national round for secondary school students. Anette-Jasmin Ansip (11c, teacher Helen Rägo) shared 14th-16th place.
- In the national round of the German Olympiad, Lene Tiinas (12b, teacher Maigi Varusk) came 4th, and Sander Metsis (12a, teacher Maigi Varusk) shared 11th-17th place.
- Gregor Vassiljev (10a, teacher Anne Aluvee) came 13th in the national round of the English Olympiad.
- In the regional round of the Maths Olympiad for secondary schools, Martin Põder (10b, teacher Kristi Kreutzberg) came first among the grades 10, Erik Julius Lindgren (10b, Kristi Kreutzberg) shared 5th-8th place, and Karolin Ruumet (10b, teacher Tiiu Sasi) came 9th. The 12th-13th place was shared by Koit Helger Panksepp (10b, Kristi Kreutzberg). Among grades 11, the 6th-7th place was shared by Laur Saks (11DP, teacher Nisha Kulkarni) and the 8th-9th place by Tõnu Uustare (11DP, Nisha Kulkarni). Martin Põder, Laur Saks and Tõnu Uustare have been invited to the national round.
- In the regional round of the Biology Olympiad for basic school students, Kaisa Tullus (7a, teacher Helen Semilarski) took 2nd place among grades 6-7, and Rahel Värton (6a, teacher Keily Ehasalu) took 12th place. Among grades 8-9, Maria Alas (9a, Helen Semilarski) took 5th place, and Laura Lotta Lipping (8a, Keily Ehasalu) took 13th place.
- A number of MHG German language students successfully participated in the national German translation competition for secondary school students: 2nd place went to Emili Sarjas (11a, teacher Heikki Veinimäe), the 4th-5th place to Lene Tiinas (12b, teacher Maigi Varusk) and 6th place to Jakob Hagu (10b, Heikki Veinimäe).
- On 22 February, the traditional QWERTY competition for Tartu 3rd-grade students took place at Tartu Veeriku School. The event was attended by teams from Lõuna TERA, Miina Härma Gümnaasium, Tartu Hansa School, Tartu Kesklinna School, Tartu Variku School and Tartu Veeriku School. The competition consisted of several parts, during which the students could drive VEX IQ robots, solve Morse code tasks and program LEGO SPIKE robots. We were represented by Andrus Alberg from 3a and Eerik Aasa from 3b, who proudly came first!



A BUSY SCHOOL HOLIDAY FOR TEACHERS

- On 1 March, the University of Tartu held Open Doors Day, where our teacher Maigi Varusk participated in the alumni discussion group "University studies and future careers".
- On 2 March, the **teachers' collaboration day** was held to prepare for setting objectives for the new strategic plan.
- On 3 March, MHG hosted the annual meeting of the Estonian History and Social Studies Teachers' Association and the national round of the Social Studies Olympiad. In addition, Alla Vinitšenko and Terje Hallik conducted a workshop on developing different study skills through assessment, and Ilmar Tammisto presented a workshop on seminar-based teaching in upper secondary schools.
