THE DEBATE SEASON TURNED OUT TO BE VERY SUCCESSFUL FOR THE FROSTIES

In the current academic year, two teams from Härma reached the quarter-finals of the annual Estonian secondary school championships in debating, with Mia Karolina Altküla (11a), Simone Nairis (11DP), Lisanna Tõnne (11DP), Brita Jõgiaas (11b) and Katrina Laur (9a)). Mia Karolina Altküla also took 10th place in the speaking category and was chosen to represent Estonia at the summer World High School Debate Championship in Vietnam.

Students participated altogether in twelve different secondary school and university competitions in Estonia and abroad during the school year.





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MEMORIES FROM THE YOUTH PARLIAMENT

On January 26-27, Lisanna Tõnne (IIDP), Simone Nairis (IIDP), Kertu Ivask (IIDP), Brita Jõgiaas (IIb) and Mia Faster (IIc) took part in a simulation of the Youth Riigikogu. The event allowed young people to take on the role of either a politician or a journalist for two days. Those interested in politics were divided into political parties, where they had to propose an amendment to a law. The Reformierakond wanted to include private money in the financing of higher education institutions, EKRE wanted to ban pornography, Keskerakond wanted to raise the property tax, the Social Democrats wanted to decriminalize cannabis, and Isamaa wanted to remove the Moscow Patriarchate from the power of the Moscow Patriarchate of the Estonian Orthodox Church.

On the second day, proposals for amendments were submitted and rejected or accepted in Riigikogu. The task of the media team during the simulation was to cover intrigues between political parties, inform the participants about important topics and interview politicians. All participants in the simulation could also listen to a lecture on political ideologies and undergo public speaking training. Representatives of political parties from Riigikogu visited the simulated political parties' factions to share more information about their daily work and answer young people's questions.


The event was very interesting and broadened the horizons, increasing the participants' knowledge of the Estonian political landscape and developing critical thinking and communication skills.


