PRACTICUM "DIFFERENT ESTONIANS"

- On 22 September, a field trip to Setomaa took place as part of the **"Different Estonians" practicum** for secondary school students, where the **guide was Anti Lillak, an alumna of MHG with Seto roots and working as a pedagogue at ERM.** History teachers Alla Vinitšenko and Kadi Küng organised the fun study trip. During the study tour, we learned the special features of the Seto cemetery and the customs of honouring ancestors at Saatse and Podmotsa cemeteries. We learned about the situation at the **Koidula border**, local mineral resources and the region's interesting history at **General Reek's house.** At each stop, our hosts used the Seto language to communicate. We learned the new words **"tsässon"**, **"vabarnas"** and **"tsäimaja"**. Typically to Härma students, the song was recorded twice - in the Seto Farm Museum under the guidance of Maret Vabarna and later in the Seto Atelier-Galerie accompanied by the gentle playing of **Kauksi Ülle** and **Evar Riitsaare.**
