ADVENT CONCERT

- On Thursday, 30 November, an Advent concert was held in Tartu Pauluse Church, opened by the combined choir with the song "Advendiküünal" conducted by Kadri Leppoja. Then, under the guidance of Külli Karask, the children's choirs of Härma school performed in front of the audience. Grade 3-4 children's choir and the mixed choir of Miina Härma Song Society performed Mari Amor's prayer "Esä taivan".
