- At the 59th Five Schools Competition, MHG students and teams achieved a good result. In Physics, **Andri Türkson** (11b, teacher Riina Murulaid) took 2nd place, **Triin Punab** (12DP, Leo A. Siiman) took 9th place. In Chemistry, **Laur Saks** (12DP) took 3rd place, and **Nurkhan Torekhanov** (Pre-IB) took 10th place. The teacher of both is Jörgen Metsik. In mathematics, **Sherkhan Torekhanov** (Pre-IB, Nisha Kulkarni) took 6th place, **Karolin Ruumet** (11a, Tiiu Sasi) took 8th place, and **Tõnu Uustare** (12DP, Signe Kinnas) took 9th place. Our students **Karolin Ruumet**, **Laur Saks** and **Triin Punab** were the best in three subjects. As a team, we took 2nd place in Physics, 3rd place in Chemistry and Mathematics, and 3rd place in the construction of the Goldberg machine.
