 On 18-20 October, the Solaride team organized the Build-a-Thon Energy hackathon. Andri Türkson (12b), Ralf Jürgenson (12DP) and Mart Väljamäe (11b) from Miina Härma Gümnaasium participated in this competition with the team "Külm ja Raske" together with Aleks Tõnnus and Giorgio Giancarlo Lelm, students of Tallinn Technical Gymnasium. The team chose Enefit's problem of finding a solution to simplify electric car charging, as users currently have to manage multiple apps and payment settings. This problem was interesting - it was the only team that took this challenge. It was particularly exciting that Enefit provided a genuine rapid charger for testing, which allowed the solution to be practically tested and demonstrated. The last day was mainly used to create the video and prepare the presentation. Although it was the only team comprising secondary school students, they surprised everyone with their professional approach. We are incredibly proud that Enefit expressed interest in further cooperation to bring the solution to the market. The team won 1st place (award of 3000 euros), the TalTech innovation award (1000 euros) and a special award from Enefit.


NOTICED AT HÄRMA
