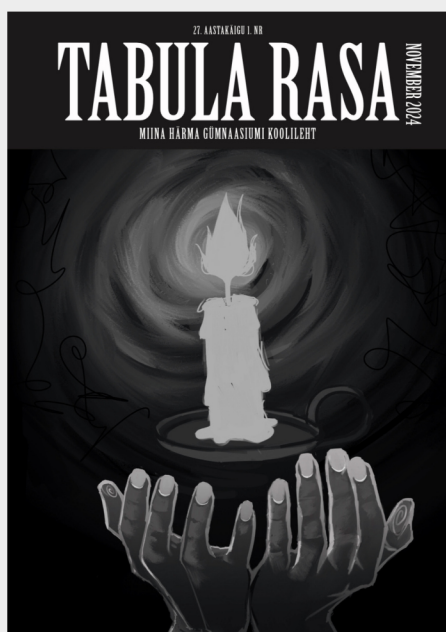


NOTICED AT HÄRMA

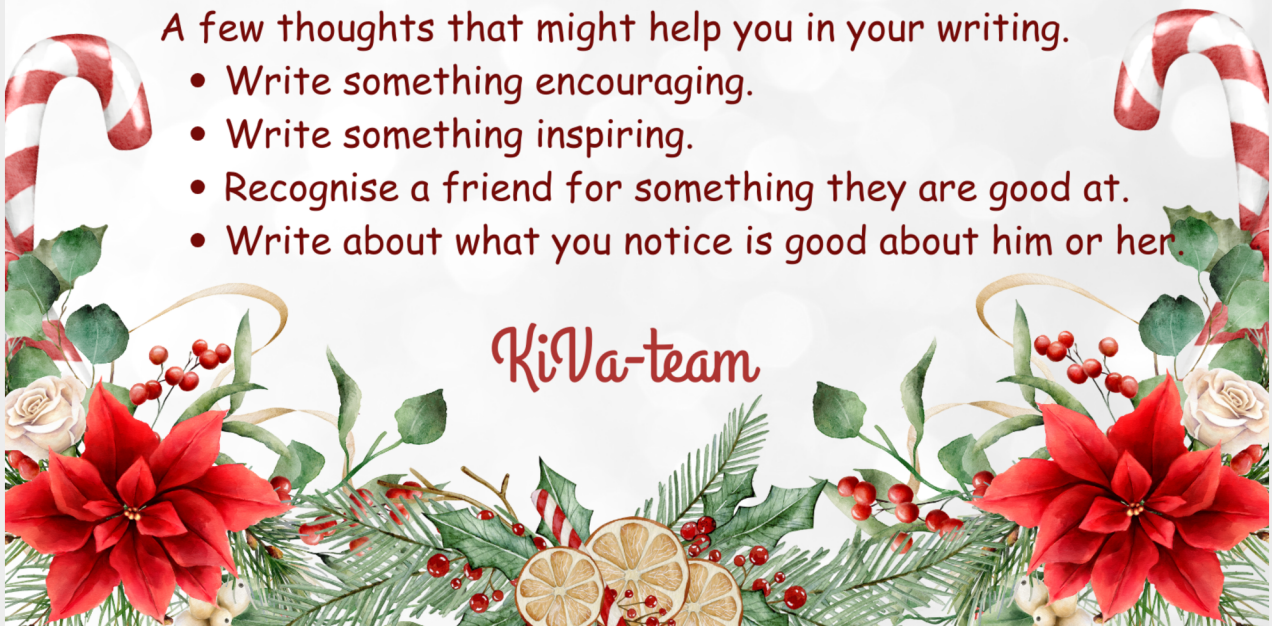
Post your own Christmas card, Christmas letter, or Christmas wish to a friend, schoolmate, or teacher in the KiVa Christmas mailbox.
