FIVE-SCHOOLS COMPETITION

- In the 60th Five Schools Competition, we achieved **3rd place as a team among schools** (2nd in Chemistry, 3rd in Physics and Mathematics). Many thanks to all seventeen students who participated in the MHG team and the teachers who supervised them!
- **The top three students in each subject were Uku Nael (11DP), Karolin Ruumet (12a), and Nurkhan Torekhanov (11DP).** They and teacher **Nisha Shailendra Kulkarni** will receive scholarships from the five-school competition.



FIVE-SCHOOLS COMPETITION

- In **Chemistry**, **Karolin Ruumet** came in 3rd place, and **Uku Nael** came in 4th place (supervised by Jõrgen Metsik). **Erik Meriloo** (10c) was the best 10th-grade competitor, coming in 5th place overall (supervised by Helle Sorge and Jõrgen Metsik). **Nurkhan Torekhanov** came in ninth place (supervised by teacher Jõrgen Metsik).
- In **Physics**, **Uku Nael** took 5th place, and **Sherkhan Torekhanov** (11DP) took 8th place (supervised by Riina Murulaid and Uku Andreas Reigo).
- In **Mathematics**, **Sherkhan Torekhanov** achieved 10th place (supervised by Signe Kinnas).
- In the team competition, the students were tasked with creating a system based on artificial intelligence models. 11 teams participated in the team competition, 4 of which completed the task correctly, including the MHG team consisting of **Otto Karl Kuuseok** (12a), **Artur Lepp** (12a), **Mattias Oll** (12DP), Kristjan Sarapuu (12b).

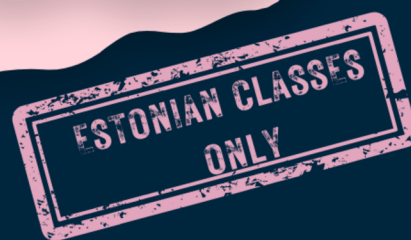
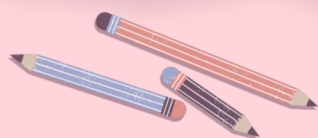
