## INCLUSIVE BUDGET PROJECT

- The first meeting of the school's inclusive budgeting project took place on 15 January, attended by 9th-grade and secondary school Entrepreneurship module students. The project aims to give students experience in participatory budgeting and democratic processes more broadly, leading to a greater understanding of the functioning and structure of the school budget.
- The Estonian Cooperation Council and Corruption-Free Estonia are carrying out the project "We Change at School." At the first meeting, the project team introduced the project and inclusive budgeting. **Marie-Liset Tauts** (12c) spoke about the activities of the Tartu Youth Council, **Eda Lemberg**, Head of Finances, introduced how the school budget is distributed, and **Kertu Vuks**, Head of the Spatial Design Department, spoke about good urban space and how inclusive budgeting could fit into it.

- On 17 January, we recognized all students in grades 6–12 and their teachers who participated in the preliminary round of the Five-School Competition in November and the main competition in January.



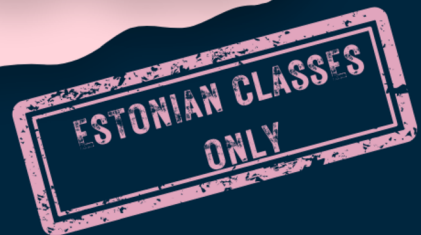

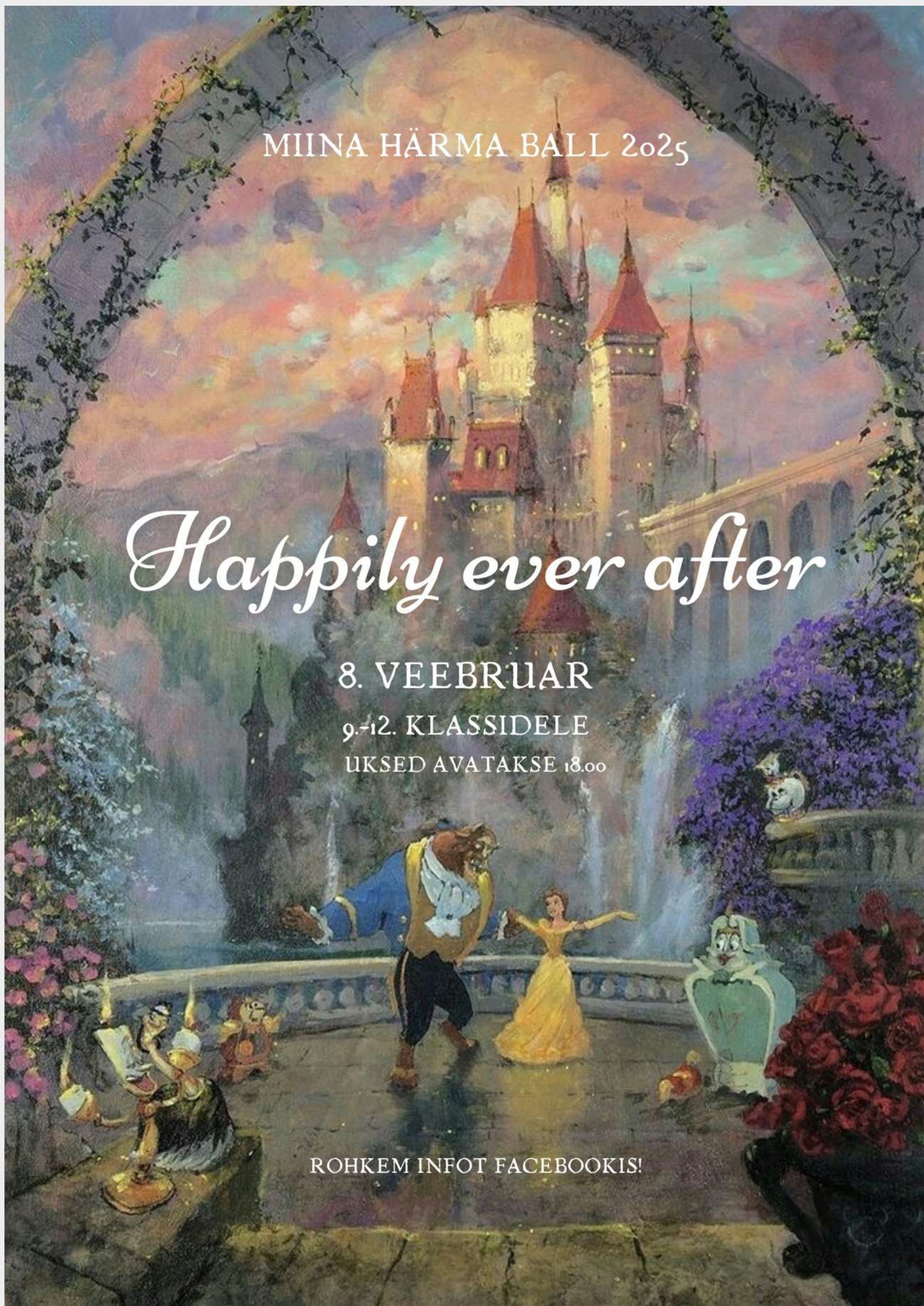
