- The winners of the **art competition "Useful Art?! The theme of the competition this year was "Man and Work". The competition was open to entries in any medium. Complete works and series of works were expected from both young artists and groups of artists. A total of 77 applications were submitted, of which four main prizes and 11 special prizes were awarded. **Piibe Jagomägi** (10b) received the **special anatomy prize** for her work **"The Beauty of Work"**.
